



OTTOMAN BEDSTEAD ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS










SAFETY/ASSEMBLY ADVICE

- Please take the time to carefully read through the following instructions before proceeding to build the bed base.
- Prepare a clear area in the bedroom to construct the base as close to the final position as possible.
- Unpack and check all contents. Please dispose of plastic bags safely.
- Keep small children away from the assembly area as small components could choke a child.
- Two people are required for safe assembly.
- Please take care when putting mattress onto slatted frame as the frame can spring open if not held in place.
- · Check bolts on the ottoman action every few months.


STEP 1.

- Unpack all components and remove packaging
- 2. Assemble the bed frame in the final required position in the bedroom
- Position headboard gently against a wall or support, and position side and end panel for assembly as shown in image right.
- Unscrew mounting bolts on the head and footboard ready to accept side rail corner brackets.




STEP 2.

- 1. Offer up side rails to headboard, insert bolts and loosely tighten.
- 2. Repeat the same process to the footboard.
- Ensure frame is square and level then tighten all bolts fully on head and footboard using the spanner provided as shown in the below image.



STEP 3.


- 1. Attach centre supports to headend using the M8 bolt and spanner.
- 2. Complete the same process for the footend.






STEP 4.


- After fitting the centre support brackets your bedstead is now ready for the two bottom panels.
- This will take two people to do safely and prevent damaging the bottom panels.



STEP 5.

- With each person standing either side of the bed, slide the bottom panels down between the hinges and support bracket. The bottom panels will rest on the rails on both side panels.
- 2. Push the panel all the way to the head end of the bed to give enough room for the next panel.







- Again using two people, angle the panel downwards and slot between the hinges and support brackets.
- 4. Push the panel all the way to the foot end.




in from the edge of the board as shown in pictures and fix into place using a Phillips screwdriver






- The bottom panels are now in position and the bed is ready to fix the slatted frames to the hinges.
- 6. If you have a 4ft6 bed please now skip to Step 8.








STEP 8.


- Push the two mattress bars into the holes both sides of the head end of the frame.
- The slatted frames are now joined and ready to fix to the hinges and base.






STEP 9.

- Identify the head end of your slatted frame, this will be the end with holes.
- Carefully lower the slatted frame into your base so that it rests on the hinges and the support brackets. Again this will take two people to do safely.
- Align the holes on the frame with the holes on the hinge and pass the four M6 x 60mm bolts through the washers provided and then into the holes each side of the frame.
- Place a nut onto each of the M6 bolts and tighten with fingers, then using the Allen-key provided fully tighten.
- 5. The slatted frame and base are now joined.





STEP 11.

WARNING: Please take care when putting mattress onto frame.

- Once both struts are fixed to the hinges the bedstead is now ready for the mattress.
- With the slatted frame in the closed position lift the mattress into place on top of the frame. Take care when doing this as the frame can spring upwards without the weight of the mattress.
